

## **CAMP EASTMAN - GENERAL POLICY STATEMENT 01/08** **For Council Units**

**UNIT CAMPING SEASON:** September 1, to April 30<sup>th</sup>

### **Time Periods:**

1. Friday at 11 AM to Saturday at 11 AM
2. Saturday at 11:05 AM to Sunday at 11 AM

Application is made in writing and accompanied by the total fee (if any) for the number of time periods requested. First come, first served (with fee) basis; no refunds unless canceled two weeks in advance. Mail applications to the Council Service Center, 3007 Flint Hills Drive, Burlington, IA 52601.

### **FACILITY FEES:**

Required damage deposit fee of \$50. If damages exceed the \$50.00 deposit, the unit or group is liable for full and complete cleanup costs and cost of repairs. (This fee is refundable back to the unit's account at the Scout office if no damage is done & proper clean up is done).

Eastman Lodge - \$60.00 per period

VFW Cabin - \$20.00 per period

Campsites - N/C

Sullivan Nature Center - \$25.00 per period

Wittkamp-Burg Hall - \$100.00 per period

It is the mission of the Boy Scouts of America to serve others by helping to instill values in young people and in other ways prepare them to make ethical choices over their lifetime in achieving their full potential.

Camp Eastman is a field laboratory for Scouting. We insist that all who use this facility will:

- Leave the property in better shape than they found it.
  - Larger wood piles than when they arrived.
  - Buildings cleaner at checkout time than when they arrived.
  - Cooking equipment cleaner after use than before.
- Not possess fireworks, a threat to people and property.
- Not possess weapons, a threat to people and wildlife.
- Not possess alcoholic beverages, drugs or controlled substances which may be detrimental to "good judgment".
- Not cut any living thing without the Camp Ranger's permission as he is knowledgeable of our camp conservation and land use plans.
- Check in and checkout. Someone is always in charge of a group. That person is responsible to see that the facility is ready for the next group--which might be yours.

"Hazing" of new campers is not part of the Scouting program and can easily lead to child abuse; this will not be tolerated.

The use of Camp Eastman is contingent upon adherence to this code of conduct. Remember that we are all "role models" for someone who is learning to make ethical choices. **GOOD CAMPING.**
