Who May Attend: All registered Boy Scout Youth; Adult waiting list pending availability after September 15<sup>th</sup>

## **Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium Scout Merit Badges Covered Requirements and Pre-Requisites**

**Oceanography-** Scouts will meet badge requirements #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7e and #9 while at the Zoo Scout Class. At home, scout will need to complete #8e-write a 500 word report about their visit to Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium or prepare a five minute speech "Why Oceanography is Important" or describe "Career Opportunities in Oceanography".

**Environmental Science-** Scouts will meet badge requirements #1, #2, #3a, b, c, d, #4a and #6 while at the Zoo Scout Class. At home, scouts will need to complete #3e, #3f, #3g and #5.

**Mammal Study-** Scouts will meet badge requirements #1, #2, partial #3, and #4, while at the Zoo Scout Class. At home, scouts will need to complete #3 and #5.

We will finish Oceanography #8 on the bus ride home. The district can arrange follow up with a local merit badge counselor to finish environmental science and mammal study.
