- WHO:** All Boy Scouts, Scouters and Parents. Webelos may camp with a Scout Troop or be assigned to a Troop if needed. Youth protection and two-deep leadership must be in place.
- WHEN:** April 13-15, 2018. Check in starting at 6 pm Friday, April 13th at 40 & 8 Park. (See Page 3)
- FEES:** \$25 per Youth and \$20 per Adult. *After March 30th*, the fee will increase to \$30 per attendee.

4:00 pm: End merit badge classes and transfer back to 40 & 8 park for troop free time.

11:00 pm: Quiet time and lights out.

Sunday April 15th

7:00 am: Breakfast on own. Break camp and clean park.
