4:00 pm: End merit badge classes and transfer back to 40 & 8 park for troop free time.

6:30 pm: Dinner on own and free time or attend Burlington Bees Baseball Game (additional TBD cost).

11:00 pm: Quiet time and lights out.

Sunday April 15th

7:00 am: Breakfast on own. Break camp and clean park.
