

Wilderness First Aid

Wilderness first aid is the assessment of and treatment given to an ill or injured person in a remote environment where definite care of a physician and/or rapid transport is not readily available. In this wilderness first aid class, students will learn how to assess, treat and, when possible, prevent medical and traumatic emergencies within the scope of their training.



Dates: April 27 & 28, 2019

Cost: \$50/Student

Camp: Students will need to bring all camping supplies to include food for meals to be cooked in campsite. Students will be expected to camp in tents as part of the class.
