 Meet at the Dining Hall

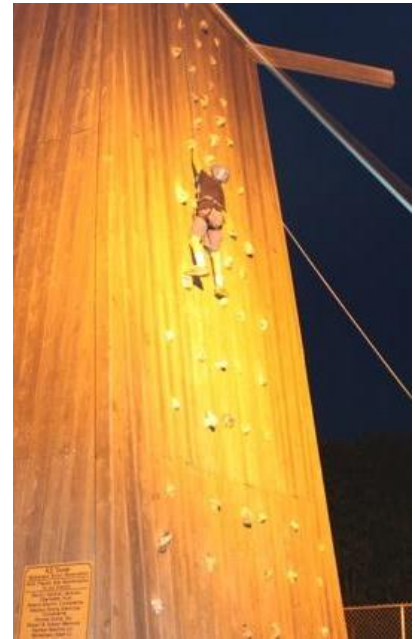
