Later, we will meet in an outdoor setting where we can learn and practice the skills of angling, together and in-person. Course Highlights

- 1. Become recognized as a BSA Certified Angling Instructor, an Official Train the Trainer Certification CS-61.
- 2. Receive a CAI patch and Certificate if attending the August 22nd Practical Day at Camp Eastman
- 3. Learn basic fly-fishing skills fly casting, fly tying, knots and how to teach them. Receive electronic copies of the Power Point slides and much more.
- 4. As a CAI you will have an opportunity to get fishing and fly-fishing equipment at greatly reduced rates for teaching Scouts.
