## Award Descriptions

**Tin Toad Award:** For someone who may have done something funny, embarrassing, or unbelievable. Someone who keeps your unit in stitches or always has a story or joke.

**Spark Plug Award:** Someone in Scouting who is always an energetic, positive thinker; always ready to accept a project, help get a job done, and generates enthusiasm in others.

**WyeKnot? Award:** For someone who simply doesn't see why something can't be done, and is willing to take on the project, see it through, and make it happen.

**Rookie of the Year:** A new volunteer, or new to scouting, or someone in a new position that takes on a task for the first time and does an amazing job worthy to be recognized.

**Family of the Year:** A family where the entire family is in scouting. They may be all in the same unit, or several units, or several levels of service, but they are all involved.

**Cubmaster of the Year:** Has your Cubmaster done an awesome job this year in providing leadership for your Pack? Give us details and help us provide recognition.

**Scoutmaster of the Year:** This award is for a Scoutmaster that has really gone the extra mile by providing leadership for a Troop. Membership and advancement both count.

**Advisor of the Year:** Does your Crew or Post Advisor deserve to be recognized for their work? We'd like to know what they've done and give them some recognition.

**Scouter of the Year:** This award is given to a top-notch volunteer that goes above and beyond the call of duty; is always willing to help out and get the job done for scouting.

**Unsung Hero Award:** This award focuses on the individual that provides critical background support, usually out of the limelight, in ways that helps a unit to be successful.

**Unit of the Year:** Every unit goes through cycles, with some strong years and some thin years. This award is issued to a unit that has shown vast improvement with a great year.

**Cooperative Teamwork Award:** This award recognizes multiple people that have come together at the right time as a team to pull off an awesome job to help scouting succeed.

**Lifetime Achievement Award:** This special award goes to someone who has had many longtime major involvements over the years with a proven track record of much success.

**District Award of Merit:** A council award issued by districts. While all service counts, it is primarily for recognizing district level service. Use the separate National form.

**Veteran's Award:** For scouting tenure in multiples of 5 years. This award is meant to be an award that you apply for yourself. Use the separate National Application form.
