Family Night & Visitors

- NO Family Night.
- Visitors are only allowed if they are there for program specific needs and are pre-approved by the Camp Director
- Visitors must still check in at the office and receive a visitor badge. Unapproved visitors will be sent home immediately.

Administrative Topics

Masks & Social Distancing

- Masks are required when indoors.
- Packs at Camp-Wide Functions must stay 30 feet apart. This will be enforced.
- Scouts are encouraged to bring a chair to the activities to spread out.
- Masks will be required at full camp functions.
