Adult Leadership Requirements

Leadership for the Jamboree requires a serious commitment of time and financial resources. Please review these requirements prior to submitting an application.

Requirements:

- Serve as a Scout or Crew Leader (Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, or other Direct Contact position) for at least one year during the period 2021 – 2023.
- Complete basic training for your position by the end of 2022.
- Complete Youth Protection training prior to attending the Jamboree.
- Complete Wood Badge training prior to attending the Jamboree.
- Commit to recruit and retain a full 36-member troop/crew for the Jamboree.
- Encourage potential Jamboree youth leadership to participate in National Youth Leadership Training.
- Commit to attend the entire Jamboree and Post-Jamboree tour in July/August. Dates to be determined.
- Be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness with your BMI in line with the national standards.
- File a Personal Health and Medical Record form with the Mississippi Valley Council.
- Complete the Adult Application and submit it to the Council Service Center by January 30, 2022
- Complete an interview with the National Jamboree Committee
- Be approved by the Mississippi Valley Council Scout Executive
