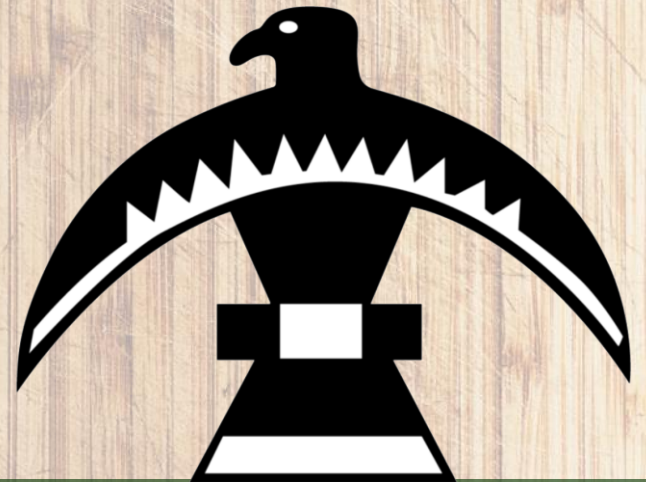

Golf Cart Policy

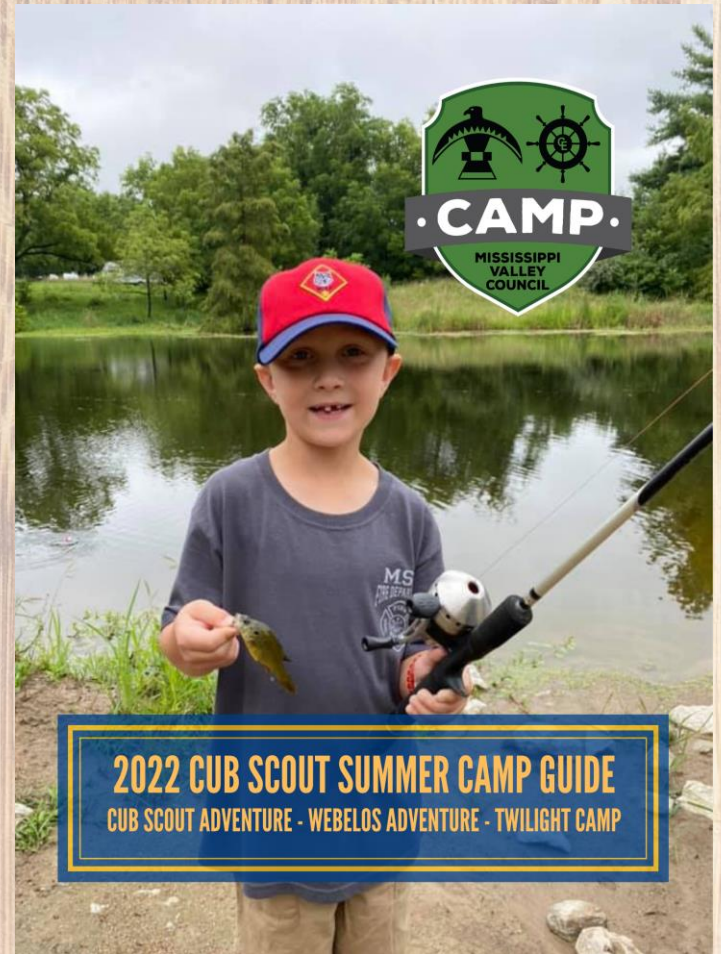
- 1) Fill Out Council Application
- 2) Operators must complete practical training through Recreational Off-Highway Vehicle Association
- 3) Operators should have medical reason to **need** vehicle
- 4) Operator must have owner's manual, first aid kit, and fire extinguisher
- 5) Must have approval from Camp Ranger, Council Program Director, **and** Camp Director
- 6) Permission to use vehicle may be revoked if used inappropriately or you do not have the required items.
